





#### Summary of Duties:

- Arrive ~0715 to the OMHS crosswalk and obtain a "STOP" flag and a safety vest inside of the school (see attached
  instructions for the exact location).
- When the school children/other pedestrians are about 10 feet away, signal traffic from both directions to stop. Some will
  unfortunately be oblivious, but make sure traffic comes to a stop safely before pedestrians cross.
- Proceed out approximately halfway into the intersection (for a single volunteer) or one quarter of the way on each side (for two people volunteering).
- Please note that those riding bicycles, scooters, etc. must dismount and walk across for safety reasons. In the past, some
  have cruised down the hill and not come to a complete stop before crossing.
- Once the school children/other pedestrians are across, return to the sidewalk and repeat until ~0815 or until traffic has died down.
- If you see someone not being safe, not paying attention to you, or anything that causes concern please report it to the BDOC. They will need: the license plate, make/color/model of the vehicle, and a general description of the individual.

# SET UP YOUR SCHOOL LUNCH ACCOUNT

## REGISTER EACH STUDENT WITH DODEA (NEW STUDENTS)

- » Obtain 10-digit DoDEA student ID# for all children from the school registrar.
- » You will need each student's ID# for step 3.

## REGISTER YOUR FAMILY ON LING CONNECT (OPTIONAL)

- » LINQ Connect is a secure, online system that allows parents/guardians to:
  - » Make Online payments for their student's meal accounts.
  - » Remotely monitor student accounts including the ability to set parental restrictions.
  - » Set up automatic recurring payments.
  - » Submit an online application for free or reduced meals.
- » If you have not already done so, you may register at lingconnect.com.
- » Click on the verification link sent to the email address provided in the step above.
- » Now you can log in at lingconnect.com using your email and password.

## OPTIONS FOR DEPOSITING MONEY INTO YOUR STUDENT'S ACCOUNT

- » Option 1: Make deposits at your local Exchange Customer Service.
  - » There is no transaction fee for this service. You will need each student's DODEA ID# obtained in step 1 above.
- » Option 2: You may send cash to school with your student to be added through your school meal cashier. There is no transaction fee for this service.
- » Option 3: Add money to your student's account through LINQ Connect at lingconnect.com
  - » Any balance left in your student's account from the previous school year will carry over to the new school year.
  - » There is a \$2.60 bank convenience fee each time you add money through LINQ Connect. To save on processing fees, you may make one payment and then transfer funds from one student account to another, provided they are listed on the same family account.
  - » Click on Add Money to Meal Account and choose either One Time Account Payment or New Recurring Payment.



Schools for children of military members stationed at various bases in the United States were already well-established. First administered by the military branches they served, the growing number of schools was soon transferred to civilian managers, then organized into two separate but parallel systems: the Department of Defense Dependents Schools (Pacific and Europe) overseas, and the Department of Defense Domestic Dependent Elementary and Secondary Schools (Americas) in the United States and its territories. In 1994, the two systems were brought together under an umbrella agency, the Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA).

#### Substitutes/Training Instructors, School Support Positions, and Administrators:

USAJOBS connects job seekers with federal employment opportunities across the United States and around the world. As the Federal Government's official employment site, USAJOBS provides resources to help the right people find the right jobs. DoDEA utilizes USAJobs for posting their non-teaching positions.

To apply, candidates will visit USAJobs at <a href="www.usajobs.gov">www.usajobs.gov</a> and create an account. The first part of this process is setting up your profile. Creating a USAJobs account and profile allows candidates to save job announcements, filter job searches, automate job search notifications, and manage everything needed to complete an application, including storing and creating resumes and required documents.

Candidates can filter job searches by location, salary, work schedule or agency to narrow their results. Review Job Opportunity Announcements and follow the instructions on what the required documents are and how to apply. You will submit your application and questionnaire in USAJobs to the agency for consideration. Candidates can check the status of their application at any time through their USAJobs account.

Applications will be adjudicated once the job announcement closes to determine qualifications and preference eligibility. The hiring manager will conduct interviews and vet the qualified referred applicants for final selection.

#### Educator/Teaching Positions

Employment Application System (EAS) is a web-based system that allows professional educators seeking employment with the Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) the ability to submit and manage their applications in an online environment 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and 365 days a year.

Candidates may apply for Classroom Teacher, School Guidance Counselor, School Nurse, School Psychologist, Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapist, and Speech Language Pathologist positions via EAS at: https://webapps.dodea.edu/EAS/login.cfm.

Once a new application is started, candidates will complete ten modules of information and preferences before finalizing their application. In the Target Jobs Module, candidates can choose the positions they are interested in for consideration. In the Target Location Module, candidates can identify the geographic locations they want to be considered for.

DoDEA requires that successful candidates meet Minimum Academic Preparation and Requirements. Candidates must be a U.S. citizen and possess a minimum of a bachelor's degree with specific coursework requirements in the specialty area they are applying. Applicants are required to provide a photocopy of all official transcripts indicating what type of degree and the date it was conferred, as well as a current valid state teaching/counseling certificate. At the bottom of the page there are links to requirements for the Elementary, Middle, Secondary, Support, and Student Support Services for various teaching categories.
